## 2021 CALENDAR (current at 3 August 2021)

**Venues:** 85 Forrest Road, Strathalbyn (Target, Field), and Goolwa Sports Stadium, Glendale Grove, Goolwa (Indoor).

**Hot Weather Policy:** When Strathalbyn's forecast temperature is 32° or greater (for juniors) and 36° or greater (for seniors) there will be no organised shooting. Club members may shoot at their own discretion but they are cautioned to be careful of heat related issues.

**Signing In:** Signing in and payment of shooting fees **MUST** be completed prior to shooting.

**WA Field Shoots:** Please book in advance for Field shoots via Archer's Diary.

**WA and AA Target Rounds:** In the calendar World Archery rounds are prefixed by "WA", eg. WA 50/720, but Archery Australia rounds do not have a prefix, eg. An "AA 50/720" will simply be listed as "50/720", however the "AA" prefix usually appears in Archer's Diary.

**Scheduled Rounds:** For GSA members, scheduled Rounds each week include all official Rounds listed in Archery Australia's Constitution and Rules. The rounds listed are a suggestion only, if members wish to shoot a round not in the calendar then they can ask the Club Recorder to add the round into Archer's Diary if they contact the Recorder at least two days before the scheduled shoot. Please note that this should be an exception and not requested frequently.

**Shooting Times:** Target and Field shoots commence at 10:00 am. Indoor shoots commence at 7:00 pm.  
Beginners courses commence at 10:00 am.

Archers may set up and shoot at any time on the day as time permits.

**GSA Open Times:** Saturdays 10:00am and other times noted in the calendar. The Forrest Road venue is available to club members 7 days a week for practice but please note the signing in and flags requirements.

**Shooting Flags:** When shooting outside scheduled times you must ensure **RED FLAGS** are displayed at the gate and clubhouse.

**Setting Up:** All archers are expected to participate in the setting up and packing up of club equipment. All archers wishing to participate in shoots are expected to be at the venue **30 minutes prior** to the commencement of shooting.

**Working Bees:** For safety, no archery is allowed until the completion of working bees (approximately 12:00 noon).

### **Club Target Championship**

- All Cubs and Intermediate, regardless of gender shoot a “GSA Newcastle” which will be 72 Arrows @ 20m. Awards to be made based on “off-the-bow” score. There will be a “Tyro” award for Cubs and Intermediates who have been shooting for less than 12 months and another for those who have been shooting longer.
- All other shooters regardless of age, gender or bow type shoot in the same competition. To even out the differences in bow types competitors would shoot the following:
  - Compound and Recurve – WA60/900 (Canberra)
  - Barebow Recurve – Short Canberra
  - Longbow – Junior Canberra

Awards will be made on the basis of handicap and off-the-bow scores. To be eligible for the handicap award the archer must have a valid handicap recorded in Archers Diary.

### **Dartchery Field**

Dart target faces will be placed on butts 1-20. The aim is to hit the ‘1’ on butt number 1, 2 on butt 2, and so on. Each archer will shoot 3 arrows and will score the target number if they shoot an arrow into the target wedge then for each additional arrow they shoot into the target wedge they score one point. For example on target 5 you get 5 points for one arrow in the 5 wedge, 5+1 if you get 2 arrows in the 5 wedge and 5+1+1 if you get 3 arrows in the 5 wedge. Any arrows landing outside the 5 wedge do not score. If an arrow breaks the line it is

considered to be in the wedge. The maximum possible score is  $(1+1+1) + (2+1+1) + (3+1+1) \dots = 250$ . The usual rules for bow type and firing marker apply.
