

GREAT SOUTHERN ARCHERS – CLUB RULES

- 1. Archers shall act, at all times when using a bow and arrow, with safety and consideration towards themselves and others.
- 2. The wearing of camouflage clothing on the ranges is prohibited. Suitable enclosed footwear must be worn at all times.
- 3. All visitors to the Club shall be directed to a Committee member of the Club on arrival at the Club.
- 4. All members and visitors on attending the Club shall sign the attendance register.

 Archers shooting must pay the range fees on the day except for designated events.
- 5. No person shall be allowed to shoot on Club ranges unless being a Club member, a member of another AA Club or being a temporary member.
- 6. Temporary members, either individually or severally, shall not shoot on the ranges without a qualified member being present.
- 7. No person is permitted to enter a Club shooting range unless shooting or undertaking an assigned task.
- 8. No animals are permitted on the Club grounds during shooting times, native and resident feral animals excepted. The native habitat is to be protected at all times. No hunting is permitted on the Club grounds.
- 9. No flora is to be cut, damaged or removed from the Club grounds without the express permission of the property officer or range captain.
- 10. Keys issued to members shall remain Club property and are not to be given to any other person. All keys are to be returned upon demand or on ceasing to be a member. A deposit must be paid prior to the issue of keys and this is refundable when membership ceases.
- 11. Whilst the Club promotes family participation in all activities, children are the responsibility of the person bringing them to the Club grounds. The person(s) responsible shall ensure that behaviour is of acceptable standard. All children under age of 16 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
- 12. No person shall touch any equipment of an archer without their consent.
- 13. No alcohol or drugs are to be taken during shoots or in breaks between shoots. Social drinks may be permitted by the Committee on particular occasions but only after all shooting has ceased. The Club does not have an alcohol consumption licence and shall not sell alcohol.
- 14. Smoking is permitted only in the carpark and nowhere else on Club grounds at any time.
- 15. All shooters in a group shall wear high visibility clothing or the Club top while shooting on the field course.
